According to § 14 in connection with § 6 of the CoronaVO as well as § 4 para. 1 of the CoronaVO study operations and the arts, the University is obliged to collect, store and, if necessary, transfer certain data to the competent authority for the purpose of tracing possible infection paths of those present.

Without providing your contact details, we cannot allow you to participate in an on-site event or other activities or to visit or use facilities at the University of Freiburg. You are also obliged to provide accurate information.

A renewed collection of your contact data is not necessary if the data is already available. This is the case, for example, if you have entered your current address and telephone number into HISinOne. Note:

According to § 14 in conjunction with § 7 of CoronaVO a **ban on entry and participation** applies to people who

- have been in contact with a person infected with coronavirus within the past 14 days,
- show typical symptoms of a coronvirus infection, such as fever, dry cough, or an impaired sense of taste or smell or
- do not wear a mouth-and-nose covering.

This ban includes the entire University campus as well as all facilities, events and activities at the University of Freiburg. According to § 19 No. 5 CoronaVO, a violation constitutes an administrative offense that is punishable by fine.

Purpose of data processing and consequences of not providing personal data: The data processing is done for the purpose of tracing possible infection chains in connection with Covid-19. Any other use of the data is prohibited. The University must exclude persons who refuse to provide their contact details from visiting or using the facility or from participating in the event.

Data categories: contact and attendance data (first and last name, address, date and time, telephone number if available, seat number if applicable)

Legal basis for data processing: Art. 6 Abs. 1 subpara. 1 lit. a, Art. 7, Art. 9 Abs. 2 No. 1 GDPR in conjunction with Art. 6 section 1 subpara. 1 lit. c, section 3 GDPR in confjunction with § 32 in conjunction with §§ 28-31 IfSG, §§ 6, 14 S. 1 Nr. 1 CoronaVO, § 4 section 1 CoronaVO study operations and the arts and Art. 6 section 1 pg. 1 lit. e, Section 3 GDPR in conjunction with § 4 State Data Protection Law (seat number)

Storage duration or criteria for determining duration: The data is stored for a period of four weeks and then deleted or destroyed: Insofar as you have deposited your address and telephone number with HISinOne for the purpose stated here, this data will be deleted upon request or upon expiration of the CoronaVO if you no longer participate in the study program. Categories of recipients: Upon request, the data collected here must be transferred to the competent authority if this is necessary for tracing pos-sible transmission pathways.

Your rights as a data subject:

- You have the right to obtain information from the University of Freiburg about the data stored about you and/or to have incorrectly stored data corrected.
- In addition, you have the right to have your data deleted or to restrict processing, as well as the right to object to processing.
- You have the right to complain to a supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of personal data concerning you is in violation of legal provisions. Such a supervisory authority is for example the Baden-Württemberg State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information, Königstraße 10a, 70173 Stuttgart, e-mail poststelle@lfdi.bwl.de.
